



Instructions For Use:

1. Place your horse's ears through the ear holes of The BuckBuster and buckle the thin strap (throat latch) on the underside- (should fit snug).
2. Buckle the thick strap on the horse's nose/Noseband- (should fit snug).
3. Tighten side straps/cheek straps according to the size of your horse- (should fit snug)
***All straps on The BuckBuster should be more snug than on your normal bridle. Not overly tight, but snug.**
4. For the next step, you will need a rein if you didn't purchase one with your BuckBuster.
 - a. Attach one end of the rein (scissor clip) to one cable end loop on The BuckBuster.
 - b. Run the rein over the saddle horn and down to the cable end loop on the other side of The BuckBuster.
 - c. Attach the end of the rein (scissor clip) to the cable end loop on that side of The BuckBuster.
5. Loop the rein around the saddle horn until the slack is fairly tight on both sides. You can also feed the rein through the hole in your western saddle and then loop it around the saddle horn until the slack is fairly tight.
 - a. You may need to adjust this depending on the behavior of the horse.
 - b. The tighter the rein is (going to the cables), the less freedom the horse will have before the pulleys activate the pressure.
 - c. The horse should be comfortable, but unable to lower its head without the pulleys activating.
6. **IMPORTANT:** After you have installed The BuckBuster, you will still need to use a bridle **OVER** The BuckBuster. The BuckBuster is designed to work with the bridle and **is not safe to use without a bridle.**
7. **BuckBuster Bridle Instructions:** Follow Steps 1-5 from above.
 - a. Attach the metal clip of the bit strap onto the upper metal D-Ring by the cheek strap buckle. Repeat for the opposite side. (Note: Your BuckBuster might already have the metal clips attached to the upper D-Rings.)
 - b. Connect your own bit and lead rein to the buckle ends of the bit straps.
 - c. Adjust the straps accordingly to fit your horse.
 - d. If you prefer to ride without a bit, simply attach your lead rein to the bottom metal D-Rings of The BuckBuster.
